



TOP 10 “DO’S” AT GRADUATION

1. DO attend graduation rehearsal on Friday, May 18 at 10:00 am. It is mandatory – **if you don’t show, graduation is a NO GO!** If you have a legitimate conflict, see Mrs. Gledhill ASAP!
2. Do leave in plenty of time to arrive at UNF by 6:00 p.m. on Monday, May 21st. Allow extra time for traffic and parking.
3. DO dress appropriately. Gentlemen - Khaki’s or other long dress pants for guys with a collared shirt. Dress shoes only—Deck shoes are ok! Ladies – dresses, skirts & blouses or long dress pants for girls. Low heeled dress shoes or sandals only.
4. DO understand that UNF security personnel will be on duty to search all bags and employ search wands to ensure your safety.
5. DO realize that your family and friends cannot be in possession of silly string, beach balls, air horns or any other items that will disrupt this very special ceremony. Tell your parents and friends that all contraband will be confiscated **AND** they will be asked to leave.
6. Do remember to **leave all valuables including your cell phone** either in your car or with your parents.
7. DO remember that you will receive nine tickets to graduation for family and friends once all senior debts have been paid. If additional tickets are available, they will be distributed at the end of rehearsal on Friday, May 18th.
8. Do wear your honor and authorized club cords. No leis, unauthorized cords or jewelry is to be worn outside of the gown.
9. DO remember that we would like you to wear the panther paw pin on your gown for the graduation ceremony. You will receive your paw pin in the robing room just prior to graduation.
10. DO remember that you may decorate your graduation caps celebrating your college or branch of service. Paint and emblems are ok but it is your responsibility to make certain your design is not distracting and inappropriate for such a solemn occasion.
