DUAL ENROLLMENT

WHAT IS DUAL ENROLLMENT?

Dual Enrollment is a program offered to Nease Students that allows students take college level courses at St. Johns River State College and earn high school credit and college credit at the same time. This opportunity is open to 10th, 11th, 12th graders.

Students may take a maximum of ten(10) Dual Enrollment credits in the fall and spring terms, and six (6) to eight (8) Dual Enrollment credits for the summer term (for a total of 2 courses maximum). There is an Early Admission/Fulltime option available as well.

How Do I Qualify?

3.0 unweighted GPA
Qualifying test scores (ACT, SAT, PERT)
High school student
Approval by school counselor/administration

Dual Enrollment students who have not taken the Pre-ACT, ACT, PSAT or SAT, may register to take the PERT through

one of SJR State's <u>Testing Center</u> locations. <u>https://www.sjrstate.edu/dual-testing</u>

Important Things To Know

- 1. No dual enrollment courses are offered at Nease. All courses are either at an SJR campus or as an online course
- 2. Transportation is the student's responsibility
- 3. Nease schedules will NOT be adjusted to accommodate a dual enrollment
- 4. Deadlines and dates for dual enrollment courses are different than Nease so it is important to keep track of everything!
- 5. Students need to check Schoology and their personal and SJR email DAILY to make sure that they do not miss any announcements or updates.
