

SJR State Three-Year Dual Enrollment Pathway to the Associate in Arts (A.A.) Degree

The 3-year pathway below is provided as an example for high school students who qualify for Dual Enrollment and wish to complete their AA degree and their high school diploma simultaneously. Students should meet with an SJR State academic advisor as well as a high school counselor to ensure the plan works with their schedule. The college courses can be taken through a combination of dual enrollment classes at the high school site, on an SJR State Campus, or online with SJR State. If the courses identified below are full or not conveniently available, please consult the *College Catalog* to choose an alternative course that meets that same AA degree requirement.
