IB Application Process Reminders

NEASE IB Teacher Recommendation (to be sent to teacher)

Zoned for Nease

- If IB is your only choice list as only choice
- If you want to do an academy or NJROTC at Nease along with IB - list the other academy/academies first/ second. (IB is considered separately so this increases your chances of getting the academy you want)
- Remember: if you select academies/programs at other schools and are chosen through the lottery, you are automatically accepted and assigned to that school!

Zoned for BHS, PMHS, or SAHS

- Since these schools offer comparable programs of choice (AICE and/or IB) you will have to be admitted to a Nease academy and/ or NJROTC to attend Nease. You may then do IB in conjunction with your academy and/or NJROTC.
- REMINDER: SAHS also offers JROTC, so must apply for a Nease academy if zoned for SAHS.
- Select all academies at Nease (if Nease IB is your priority).
- Once you submit notify IB
 Coordinator at Nease that you
 would like to apply for IB and have
 your teachers send
 recommendations. Please note that
 there is not a separate application
 for IB, but this let's the coordinator
 know to look at your transcripts/
 scores and review
 recommendations
- If you are selected for Nease via the lottery, you will then be notified if you were selected for IB as well.
 Reminder: you have to notify coordinator during application window to be considered!

Zoned for BTHS, CHS, PVHS, or TCHS

- If IB is your priority and top choice - list as only choice, or only along with other Nease academies (list after other academies).
- If you want to do an academy or NJROTC at Nease along with IB - list the other academy/academies first/ second. (IB is considered separately so this increases your chances of getting the academy you want)
- Remember: if you select academies/programs at other schools and are chosen through the lottery, you are automatically accepted and assigned to that school!

FAQ:

Are IB students accepted via lottery?

- IB, as a program of choice, offers acceptance via merit, not the lottery.
- REMEMBER:
 - If you list other schools' programs and are selected for one of those, you are assigned to that school regardless of potential IB acceptance.
 - If you are zoned for another program of choice school, you must first be selected for an academy at Nease via lottery before receiving acceptance to IB. (But need to notify coordinator during application window to be considered!)

Is there a separate application for IB?

 No! But if zoned for another IB or AICE school, will need to email coordinator to be considered.

Do I email my scores and report card?

- No!
- Unless you are not currently attending a SJCSD school, then reach out to coordinator

Should I send supplemental information?

 No! All students applying are considered by reviewing the same criteria

Do I need to do anything extra to apply?

 Yes! You will need to give your 4 core subject area teachers the recommendation form, or send link to digital form. They then need to submit directly to coordinator or via digital form by January 26.
