2018-2019 Student Parking Rules & Regulations

The following guidelines exist to help ensure the safest and most efficient use of our limited parking facilities. Please return the 2nd page of this form signed by student and parent. The rules & regulations list below is not an all-inclusive list. The Administration reserves the right to revoke a student's parking pass for disciplinary reasons. Parking privileges are reviewed at the end of each nine weeks' grading period. Student parking rules, regulations, and criteria will be reviewed/revised throughout each semester to evaluate space, safety, need, etc. Students are expected to follow all guidelines within the St. Johns County Student Code of Conduct for maintaining a safe and orderly environment in the parking areas.

1. Driving to school is a PRIVILEGE, not a right. (Buses are available for all students residing within the Nease High School attendance zone.) To be eligible to purchase students must settle any outstanding fines.
2. Parking is reserved for seniors first and juniors. Sophomores can only drive if they purchase at tag through one of the auctioned spots. There will be no exceptions. Students who sell their parking permit to sophomores or other students, will be suspended and the parking permit will be revoked.
3. Parking permits are \$100. There will be no refunds. Replacement permits cost \$35.
4. All students will be allowed to paint their parking spot for an additional \$50. The top 20 in the senior class that receive a spot will be allowed to paint their spot for free. We will have a painting day on a Saturday in August and students will pay then. Nease will be responsible for painting over the spots at the end of the school year. If anything is painted that is inappropriate, it will be painted over.
5. If, in an emergency, you must drive a different vehicle than registered, please put your hanging tag in the new vehicle and notify Dean Hurst of the change.
6. The parking permit will have a number on it that identifies the student driver. It should be hanging from your rear view mirror with the number facing out at all times. There are no exceptions.
7. Student parking is located in the large lot in front of the school and football stadium. The spots are numbered and you may ONLY park in the numbered spot that matches your parking tag. There will be no parking on the street adjacent to the school or in any other undesignated area.
8. Any vehicle that does not have a current NHS parking permit displayed or is parked in any undesignated area is subject to receiving a \$25 ticket or being immobilized (a parking boot will be placed on the tire). If your vehicle is immobilized, the cost to have the boot removed is \$50 and will result in the loss of your driving privileges for the following nine weeks. NHS is not responsible for inconveniences resulting from the time necessary to obtain payment for fines or for removal of the boot.

9. All vehicles are subject to search. Possession of drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, pocket knives or weapons of any kind will result in an out of school suspension and loss of driving privileges.
10. The parking area is off limits to all students during the day. You must get a pass from one of the Deans if you need to access your vehicle. If you are in the parking lot without a pass for any reason (getting books, getting your lunch, bringing something out to your car, etc), you could lose your parking permit.
11. Students are responsible for their vehicle and its contents.
12. On campus, any student seen passing illegally, driving too fast, driving on the grass, not yielding to the buses or any other type of careless driving will lose their parking permit.
13. Students who receive a ticket must pay the fine within 48 hours or they will receive a \$5. Additional charge. If the ticket is not paid in 7 days, the student's vehicle will be booted for an additional \$50 charge. The student will also incur a 9 weeks suspension of their parking permit.
- 14. Students with over 15 days of unexcused absences will lose their parking permit for the remainder of the year.**
15. Students who are tardy to 1st period will receive the following consequence.
 - 4 tardies – loss of pass for 1 week
 - 5 tardies – loss of pass for 1 month
 - 6 tardies – loss of pass for 45 days
16. Any students who leave campus without permission from the school will be suspended and lose their permit for 9 weeks.
17. Students are expected to be in the student parking lot by 9am to assure that they are not tardy to 1st period.
18. If you are driving a new vehicle or get a new license plate, you must have it changed in our computer immediately, please see Dean Hurst the day of arrival with the new vehicle or license plate.

Thank you for your assistance and cooperation in making Nease High School a safer place for all of our students.

Parking is a privilege at Nease High School and spots will be assigned through a lottery system after specialty programs are given priority consideration by Administration. To maintain a parking spot, we expect students to maintain above a 2.0 GPA, **have good attendance**, and follow all school rules. Parking passes may be suspended or revoked, if a student violates the District's Code of Conduct.

Nease will have 661 student parking spaces for 18-19. We will reserve 31 of these spots to auction as fundraisers for different sports/programs. Nease will sell 630 spots at \$100 each to Seniors and Juniors ONLY.

Students can also opt to share a space. Each student would pay \$50 towards the space and the students would have to work it out between them as to who would drive to school and have the tag each day.

The deadline to submit a completed form to Nease's main office is 5pm Friday, April 13th. Priority will NOT be given to how early the form is submitted. NO EXCEPTIONS will be granted for this deadline!

Students will be notified on Friday, May 4th if they have been selected for a parking space. Those selected will have until 5pm Friday, May 18th to pay the \$100 parking fee and submit required paperwork or their spot will be forfeited and given to a student on the waiting list.
