

Nease High School- Student Parking Rules & Regulations 2020-2021 School Year

DRIVING TO SCHOOL IS A PRIVILEGE, NOT A RIGHT. The following guidelines exist to ensure the safest and most efficient use of our parking facilities. **ONLY JUNIORS AND SENIORS** will be eligible to purchase a parking permit through the online application. Sophomores may bid on a parking pass through on-campus auctions. No freshman may drive on campus. This is not an all-inclusive list; the school administration reserves the right to revoke a student's parking tag.

1. The cost is \$100. Parking tag fees are non-refundable, non-transferable.
2. The student must be in good attendance, academic and disciplinary standing and have all fines and debts cleared.
3. All vehicles parking on campus must have the parking tag displayed in their vehicle at all times. Parking tags are non-transferable. If you move, your tag must be returned to NHS at the time of transfer. Tags must be hanging from rear view mirrors with number facing out at all times. No exceptions.
4. Parking tags may only be shared with a sibling. Both students must be a Junior and/or Senior to drive on campus and their respective driver's license, insurance and vehicle registration must be on file.
5. Students are expected to be in the student parking lot by 9 a.m. to assure that they are not tardy to first period.
6. Student parking is located in the large lot in front of the school and football stadium. Juniors who were issued parking tags are to park behind the yellow line in front of the clinic and gravel area in any open spot. Seniors who were issued parking tags are to park in the spaces forward of the yellow line in the parking lot closest to campus except the numbered reserved spaces.
7. You may **NOT** park in the Reserved Spaces 1-47 unless you are assigned this space. Drivers with reserved parking spaces are to park in your assigned numbered parking space. If someone is in your space, report it to Mrs. Cioffi in Room C-119.
8. No students will be allowed to go to their vehicle during the school day without written permission from a Dean.
9. All vehicles are subject to search. Possession of drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, vapes, juuls, pocket knives or weapons of any kind or any other items not in compliance with the Code of Conduct will result in out of school suspension and loss of driving privileges. Not knowing that these items were in your vehicle will not change the consequences.
10. Neither NHS nor the St. Johns County School District are responsible for any damages or losses to vehicles parked at NHS.
11. Parking in a handicap space in the student parking lot requires a state issued handicap tag and student parking tag and both must be displayed.

Fines

All parking fines should be cleared within 48 hours. Each day beyond 48 hours will incur a \$10 per day additional fee. Student will not be able to park on campus until all parking fines are paid in full.

- **\$25:** Failure to be in compliance with any of the parking rules outlined in the Parking Rules & Regulations
- **\$100:** Replacement parking tag

Boot

Once a boot is placed on a vehicle, all fines AND a boot removal fee (\$50) must be paid **prior to the boot being removed**. NHS is not responsible for any inconvenience that may result from the time necessary to obtain payment of all fines or the removal of the boot.

ALL UNPAID FINES, EXCESSIVE TICKETS, AND/OR UNAUTHORIZED PARKING MAY RESULT IN A BOOT BEING PLACED ON THE STUDENT'S CAR AND ADDITIONAL CHARGES WILL BE INCURRED FOR ITS REMOVAL.

Suspensions or Revocation of Parking Tags:

- Students with excessive tardies and/or absences to their first period class in a quarter- 5 tardies (5 school days); 6 tardies (10 school days); 7 tardies (15 school days); 8 + tardies (30 days or remainder of quarter, whichever is longer).
- Students with 15 days of unexcused absences (revoked for 30 days so long as student has no additional absences in that time).
- Students leaving campus without permission or taking another student off campus who does not have permission to leave (revoked for 10 days).
- Unlawful speed, talking/texting on your phone while operating vehicle or reckless driving on campus (revoked for 10 days).
- Level 4 disciplinary actions per the St. Johns County Student Code of Conduct (permanently revoked).
- Students identified as selling/giving or buying/accepting parking tags (permanently revoked).
- Allowing another student to park in your assigned parking spot (if you have a reserved space) or trading parking tags with another student and not notifying Mrs. Cioffi in Room C-119 for prior approval (revoked for 10 days).
- Excessive violation of school rules (i.e. skipping class; defiance/disrespect; inappropriate conduct, class disruptions)- (revoked for 15 days).
- Students who continue to park on campus without a parking tag or while their parking tag is revoked will have their vehicle booted and their parking privileges revoked for the remainder of the year.
- **Students found on campus with another student's parking tag or a counterfeit parking tag will be ineligible for parking for the remainder of their time at NHS. This includes sophomores and freshman.**

If a student loses their parking privileges, the vehicle registered to that parking tag is not allowed on campus. Refunds will not be given to students who lose their parking privilege (suspended or revoked) for disciplinary reasons.
