ONLY 5 DAYS UNTIL THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL! The following is a special edition of the Panther Press to discuss tomorrow's Panther Pickup and Friday's Open Campus. Please review the following with your student:

PANTHER PICKUP

DATE: **Thursday, August 8**

WHO/WHEN:

- 9th/10th Grade – 8:00AM – 11:30PM
- 11th/12th Grade – 1:00PM – 3:30PM

HOW:

- If you are going to attend, [CLICK HERE>>](#) to register (if you have not already). If you have more than one student attending, please attend the time slot of the oldest student in your family.
- If you are unable to attend the event, your student will be provided similar opportunities during Link Crew Orientation for freshmen/new students or will be able to walk the campus on Friday, August 9th's Open Campus event.

WHAT: The event will occur using the following procedure:

- **STEP 1: ENTRY**

- Panther attendees will enter through the **PANTHER HALL BREEZEWAY**. Upon entry they will check in by showing Nease employees their Leonard's Digital ID through the Leonard's Digital ID app. Students will be given assistance to get their Digital ID if not previously downloaded.

- **STEP 2: HAC ACCESS CHECK**

- Student schedules will be available in HAC the day of Panther Pickup! Students will be asked if they can pull up their schedules in HAC:
 - If a student can access their schedule in HAC, they move on to STEP 3.
 - If a student **CANNOT** access their schedule in HAC, they will be sent to the auditorium for assistance and then move on to STEP 3.
 - **TIP! Save time and have your student pull up their schedule in HAC before arriving to Panther Pickup!**

- **STEP 3: Code of Conduct Acknowledgment and Digital Citizenship Assessment Form**

- Students will go into the media center and check to see if they have completed their **MANDATORY** Code of Conduct Acknowledgment and Digital Citizenship Assessment Form. This **MUST** be completed before moving to STEP 4.

- **STEP 5: CAFETERIA**

- The following resources will be available in the cafeteria:
- **LOCKER “RENTAL”**
 - Students will be able to pick out a locker for the 2024-2025 school year. PLEASE NOTE that lockers will also be available during the second week of school during lunch.
 - **TIP! We HIGHLY RECOMMEND that you walk your student’s schedule before selecting a locker OR have your student wait until the 2nd week to determine if they want/need a locker. Your student may not need one!**
- **PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM PICKUP**
 - If already purchased, PE uniforms will be available for pickup if previously purchased by July 23.
 - If you still need to purchase a PE uniform [CLICK HERE>>](#) and your student can pickup their uniform in their PE class.
- **PTSO, IB, GOLDEN PANTHER, and BAND BOOSTER INFORMATION**
 - Meet with our amazing booster clubs and support our Panthers!
- **STUDENT PARKING TAG PICKUP**
 - Parking tags will be available for Junior and Senior students who have paid for AND successfully registered for their parking tags!
 - **PLEASE NOTE! PARKING TAGS WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE FOR PICKUP DURING THE MORNING SESSION. THEY WILL ONLY BE AVAILABLE IN THE AFTERNOON BETWEEN 1:00PM - 3:30PM.**

- We currently do not have any more parking tags available for purchase. Please contact Assistant Principal Trevor Abbs at trevor.abbs@stjohns.k12.fl.us to be placed on the parking waitlist.
- **STEP 6: WALK YOUR SCHEDULE!**
 - Walk your schedule for Green, Gold, and Excel Days
- **STEP 7: EXIT**
 - Panther attendees will exit through the PANTHER HALL BREEZEWAY, **the same location they entered.**

If your student cannot attend during Panther Pickup, they can also come on campus for Friday's OPEN CAMPUS event.
