**The PSAT/NMSQT will be facilitated on the Nease High School campus this upcoming Wednesday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>.** As a reminder, all 10th Grade students will sit for the PSAT. Only 9th and 11th Grade students who have **ALREADY** paid to take the PSAT/NMSQT will participate.

**To provide the best testing environment for students and to have enough teachers to administer the exams, students NOT TESTING have the option to take a digital learning day at home. All students will be given an assignment from their teacher that will be submitted. Students not taking the PSAT who choose to attend school, will sit in the cafeteria and use a laptop to complete online assignments.**

If your student is testing, please use the grade level links below to find your child's assigned testing room. Students need to report directly to their assigned room no later than 9:20am.

**To participate in the test, STUDENTS MUST HAVE A PHOTO ID.** Students are allowed to bring their own calculators but it must be on the following [approved College Board list](#). Students will be testing on a computer until 12:45pm. There will be one 10-minute break. Students should bring a small snack and water.

**At 12:45pm, students will be released from testing for lunch or dismissal IF they have the early release form with parent signature to submit at the student gate to leave campus.**
