To help raise money for the relief efforts in North Carolina and the surrounding area after Hurricane





Please keep in mind that the FHSAA requires all student-athletes to view free NFHS video courses on concussions, heat illness, and sudden cardiac arrest (see instructions below). Signatures on the EL3 form indicate that your athlete has completed these three video courses. The FHSAA also requires that all student-athletes have at least a **2.0 unweighted GPA** to be eligible for participation.





The Family Portal provides a central location for your student's assessment results.

The Family Portal can be used to:

- access your student's results for FAST Progress Monitoring testing, EOCs, Statewide Science, Retakes, the Florida Civic Literacy Exam, and the Florida Alternate Assessment
- access prior statewide assessment results.
- print score reports.

How can I access the Family Portal?

What information do I need to log in to the Family Portal?

- Your student's unique 6- digit access code (found in HAC under the Registration tab).
- Your student's date of birth.
- Your student's first name as it appears on their official school record.

- Your student's Individual Student Reports with interpretative guides.
- Glossary
- FAQs
- Performance Levels
