

2025 Early Release for AP/IB Exams

The Allen D. Nease High School AP and IB exams are from April 29th to May 16th. Students taking an AP or IB exam are allowed to come to school late or leave school early on the days they are testing. AP morning exam arrival time is 7:30 AM and afternoon exam arrival time is 11:30 AM. IB morning exam arrival time is 8:30 AM and afternoon exam arrival time is 12:30 PM. Exams last from 90 mins to 3 hours with extended time exams lasting longer. Students must stay until the conclusion of the standard exam time.

If you want your child to come to school late or leave early, either as a student driver or parent pick-up, please sign below. Students should bring the signed form as their excused tardy or early dismissal permission. Your child will need a SIGNED form for EACH exam they are taking. Pictures of the forms are not acceptable.

Students **WITHOUT** a signed form will be released at the normal school end time of 3:50 PM. Students **CANNOT** check out **DURING** AP or IB exams. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS. Their exam will be invalidated should this occur.




