# Attendance Procedures

#### **ABSENCES**

### Was your student absent from school? Complete the Absence Reporting Form:

- LINK: https://bit.ly/NHS-AbsenceForm
- The digital Absence form must be filled out online within 2 days of returning to NEASE for the absence to be excused. It may NOT be emailed.
- Filling out the Absence form does not guarantee an excused absence.
- Entries to absence forms will be pulled at 1pm each day. Please allow 48-72 hours for change to occur in HAC.
- Only a parent or a legal guardian may fill out absence forms unless you are submitting a doctor's note.
- Any absence over 15 days requires official documentation to be excused. (Medical notes OR statement from court)
- Only a physician's office is authorized to fax a note for the student to be excused. The fax number is 904-547-8305 Attention Nease HS Attendance Office.
- Phone calls, emails, or faxes from parents are not accepted.
- Please note that students are only allotted one day off for observance of religious holidays.
- If your child was marked absent and you believe this was done in error, please contact the teacher FIRST

#### **EARLY CHECK OUT**

### Need to check out your student early for an appointment, use the Early Check Out Form:

- A PARENT or GUARDIAN must submit a digital Early Check Out form by 10am to the attendance office.
- Emails, phone calls, and faxes will not be accepted to check-out early.
- An Early Check Out form is also REQUIRED when a student needs to drive off campus during school hours.
- We will contact a parent/guardian before a student is allowed to drive off campus early. Please be available and include the best phone number to reach you on the form. Students will NOT be issued a pass without speaking to a parent or guardian.
- To excuse an early release absence, required documentation must be uploaded using the Excused Absence Form or turned in to the front office within 2 days of returning to NEASE.

# PSAT-NMSQT

#### Deadline for 9th & 11th to register is Sunday, September 14, 2025.

There are NO exceptions to this deadline as the exam is now computer-based and College Board has a hard deadline for schools to register.

Please see below for specifics on 9th, 10th, and 11th grade test date specifics. Nease High School will administer the PSAT/NMSQT (Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test – **National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test**) to students on **Wednesday**, **October 22**, **2025**. The purpose of the test is to give all students an opportunity to experience taking a college readiness test and identify students who might benefit from advanced coursework. **The PSAT is also the exam that is used for 11th graders to qualify for the National Merit Scholars** 

There is **no need** to register **10th grade students**, they will receive their test at **no cost**, through state funding. However, if 10th grade students choose to opt-out please return <u>PSAT-10th-Grade-opt-out-letter</u> to Cynthia

**Program.** Additionally, a score of 430 on the PSAT Math qualifies as a concordant score for the Algebra I EOC.

**9th graders** wishing to take the test, must be in **Geometry or HIGHER**. If you qualify to test, you must register online. Please click here to register and pay: <u>PSAT SchoolPay</u>

Messenger in PH 225, or at the front office desk.

The last day to pay & register will be midnight on **September 15**, **2025**. There is NO possibility of testing if payment is not received by this date. PSAT/NMSQT scores are typically available online 4–6 weeks after the test administration.

Students in **11th grade** wishing to take the test must register online. Please click here to register and pay: <u>PSAT SchoolPay</u>. The last day to pay & register will be midnight on September 15, 2025. There is NO possibility of testing if payment is not received by this date. PSAT/NMSQT scores are typically available online 4–6 weeks after the test administration.

**Students with a IEP or 504 Plan,** please be sure to complete the accommodation consent request and return to Ms. Messenger by **August 22, 2025**, in PH 225. **This must be processed by this time for CollegeBoard to approve your school-based accommodations.** Requests after this date will not be processed and students will test without school-based accommodations. Consent Form

If you have already applied for accommodations with CollegeBoard, **you do not need to apply again**, you retain the accommodations until one year after your graduation date. However, if your accommodations change, it is YOUR responsibility to complete a new form and resubmit in plenty of time. Students will receive an Official Student Guide to the PSAT/ NMSQT® through their English classes. This guide contains valuable information as well as a full-length practice test with answer keys. # Student IDs

Dear Panther Families,

Allen D. Nease High School is excited to introduce MINGA, our new platform that we will be using to manage Student IDs for the 2025-2026 school year through our Cady Studios partnership.

A student is REQUIRED to have their Student ID available on their person AT ALL TIMES while on the Allen D. Nease High School campus. Students will need to have the ID digitally on their phone or request a hard copy of the ID through the media center before school. PLEASE NOTE that hard copy student IDs have not been provided to us by our vendor yet. Once we have them, we will send out an additional message through ParentSquare.

Student IDs are used frequently on our campus for tardies, student check-in, student check-out, lunch purchases, and for special events.






### International Baccalaureate






