

Nease High School 2026-2027 Scheduling Guidelines

For **Current 10th graders** in the 2025-2026 school year

Checklist for the course registration process (All links are also on the Nease website)

☐	Watch the Scheduling PowerPoint
☐	Review course progressions for each subject area
☐	Read course descriptions in Course Catalog
☐	Review Standard Diploma Requirements
☐	Review requirements for Florida Bright Futures Scholarship
☐	Discuss with parent/guardian courses for next year. Changes to classes are due May 29, 2025
☐	Complete your course verification sheet and bring your signed sheet to your registration appointment. (Directions below)
☐	Login to HAC from July 22-23 rd to review final course placements.

How to complete 2025-2026 course verification sheet:

1. Review recommended courses by core teachers.
 - If you agree with the course selections and no changes are needed, no action required.
 - If you want to change the level of an academic course, make a note in the parent comment box and it will be discussed during the registration appointment with the school counselor.
2. Select your scheduling method and complete the associated additional information.
3. Select the number of periods that you plan to be on campus. Co-Op students can have 1 period off for every 5 hours worked (max of 2 periods). Dual Enrollment students can have 1 period off for each DE course plus 1 travel period if they are taking an in-person course. Students taking 4+ Dual Enrollment courses are considered full-time and do not need to attend Nease. Scheduling options can be combined.
4. Select a minimum of 5 electives from the back and label them in priority order (1 being first and so on).
5. Read and initial all sections on the front of the form. Sign and date the bottom.

Important Dates:

January 26-February 6, 2026: Counselors will meet with students to discuss courses through their English classes.

May 29, 2026: LAST DAY to make schedule changes

July 22-23, 2026: Schedule Preview

August 6, 2026: Final date for ALL schedule changes

August 10, 2026: First Day of School!
