



**Notes:**

1. College-bound students should take two years of the same language. Some colleges, outside of the state of Florida, may NOT accept ASL as a foreign language requirement. Please check with your prospective school to determine if credit will be awarded. Two years of a world language can be a requirement for a four-year university (SUS- state university system) and is required for Bright Futures. Competitive schools are looking for 3+ years of a World Language.
2. Students with a D in level 1 will not be allowed to move to level 2. They will repeat level 1.
3. Students moving up to level 3 and 4 must demonstrate an A/B in previous two classes.
