ACADEMY SENIORS: TIME TO ORDER YOUR GRADUATION CORD

Academy seniors, if you have been enrolled in the Communications, Engineering or Hospitality Academy for at least three years, you are eligible to purchase an Academy cord. You must sign up for a cord via the Sign up genius:

Cords cost 8 dollars. You must sign up and pay by February 27th.

Communications Academy students get blue cords, Engineering Academy students get red cords, and Hospitality Academy students get aqua cords. Please make sure you only sign up for the Academy you have been enrolled in for at least 3 years. If you sign up under the wrong Academy, the wrong color cord will be ordered for you and the correct cord will not be available. Additionally, if parents sign up via the Sign Up Genius, they must enter their student's name in the comment.

ACADEMY INTENT TO RETURN PROCESS: CONTINUING IN A PROGRAM OR DROPPING ONE FOR 2026-27

In December, all Communications, Hospitality, and Engineering Academy students were asked to indicate if they want to remain in their current Academy for the 2026-27 school year by signing an Intent to Return roster. If the student checked “Yes,” then that student will be automatically re-enrolled in the Academy for 2026-27. The student will also receive a recommendation to move on to the next level Academy course, as long as they are meeting Academy requirements. If an Academy student checked “No” on the roster to indicate that they do not want to continue in the Academy next year, a Program of Interest Drop Form has been sent home with those students. The drop form must be completed by the student and parent and returned to Mrs. Combs in order to remove the student from the program for 2026-27. SUMMER CAMP OPPORTUNITIES

It definitely feels like winter out there...but summer will be here in no time! Here are three camps that align with our Academy programs:

COMMUNICATIONS ACADEMY STUDENTS: UF'S SUMMER MEDIA INSTITUTE

The University of Florida Summer Media Institute is expanding! For the first time ever, they are going to hold two sessions this summer to help meet demand. Session 1 runs June 18-23 and focuses on journalism and communication disciplines. Session 2 runs June 24-29 and will focus on sports journalism and media. SMI is now an application-based program. Students will need to submit an application by March 5. Students accepted will be notified March 6-10 and have a two-week period to register and pay the registration fee, which will save their spot. Registration costs \$999 (includes camp, lodging and food) and the scholarship form is part of the initial application. You can learn more about SMI at
